English as an Additional Language (EAL) PROVISION



- Meeting EAL needs is the responsibility of all teachers. An Additional Needs Register is available to all staff and identifies students with specific inclusion needs including EAL.
- Students with EAL are referred to REMA for assessment if they are new to the country or have difficulties developing English skills.
- Students with EAL are taught the National Curriculum with suitable differentiation and support. In some cases the curriculum is modified.
- Subject staff continually monitor the progress of students with EAL and raise concerns if progress is not in line with expectations. At this point the student may be referred for further assessment of their needs.
- The school pays for the services of the specialist teacher from REMA as well as some LSA support.
- Staff are welcome to seek advice for meeting the needs of their students with EAL.
- The school also employs a multi-lingual community link worker.
