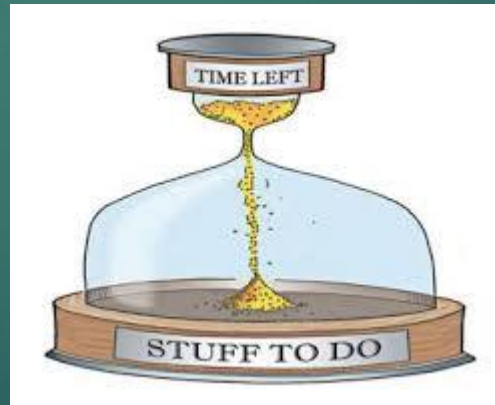


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# Year 11 Coursework Information Evening

# Fullbrook 6

School based 6<sup>th</sup> Forms deliver 68% of A levels nationally.  
They have smaller class sizes too!

Attainment is higher in school based 6<sup>th</sup> forms, nationally and locally!

More likely to go on to University from a school 6<sup>th</sup> form than a College (59%:39%)

28% of our students go to top 30% universities.  
16% go to Russell Group (College 16% & 9%)

We out perform local college with average point score and %AAB

## **Helpful Hints for the Literature exam**

- ▶ Quiet place to read and study
- ▶ Re-read set texts
- ▶ Record quotations on post-its, flash cards, mindmaps etc.
- ▶ Create mindmaps/flash cards relating to the characters and themes in set texts.

# Science – 100% examination

## Separate Science

3 GCSEs

- Biology – 2 x 1.45 minutes
- Chemistry – 2 x 1.45 minutes
- Physics – 2 x 1.45 minutes

## Trilogy (Sets 1 to 5)

2 combined Science GCSEs

- Biology – 2 x 1.15 minutes
- Chemistry – 2 x 1.15 minutes
- Physics – 2 x 1.15 minutes

Higher papers- Grades 4-9

Foundation papers- Grades 1-5

## Revision guides –

- Separate Science- Total of £11.99 for all three guides
- Trilogy (Combined Science)- £9.00 for one large guide containing all 3 subjects
- Letters on revision guides were given out last year, spare copies will be available in reception

## Science support-

- Drop in sessions will run on Monday night up until Christmas
- Science revision sessions will start at Christmas on Monday night
- Revision sessions will run in Easter

# For all for languages, students need to be revising and learning vocabulary from all topics for their exams – little and often.



There are no controlled assessment tasks for French, German, Spanish. 4 exams = 25% each. Foundation (Grades 1-5 or Higher (Grades 4-9)).

Urdu : 2 x Speaking Controlled Assessments and 2 x Written Controlled Assessments = 60% of overall grade. Urdu Listening and Reading exams 16th May.

- ▶ French, German and Spanish mock oral exams : 27th-29th November.
- ▶ French, German and Spanish actual oral exams : 8th-11th May. 25% of overall grade.
- ▶ French, German, Spanish are all assessed in the form of terminal exams.
- ▶ French 15th and 18th May : German 18th and 21st June : Spanish 6th and 14th June.
