New System for Assessing Student Progress

As you are aware from the Principal's recent newsletter and in line with DfE changes, the system for assessing student progress will change from September 2016 for all students in Years 7-11.

Levels used at Key stage 3 will cease to exist; grades at GCSE will move to 1-9; and progress from Year 7 to 11 will be shown on a scale of 0-100.

To explain the new system you are invited to attend an information evening on one of the following dates:

Tuesday 12 July	7-8pm	Years 7 and 8
Wednesday 13 July	7-8pm	Years 9, 10 and 11
Thursday 14 July	6-7pm	Additional date if places are not available on Tuesday or Wednesday evening

Please note that the new system will be explained to students during their tutor times and therefore students should not attend so that as many places as possible are available to parents/carers.


Places must be booked for these evenings via the Parents Evening Booking System. To do this you will need to go to the Fullbrook school website. Click the **'Useful Links'** button located on the top right of the screen (second link from the right); then click the **'Parents Evening Booking System'** tile. This will bring you to the online booking system web page. Fill in your details where required and click **'Login and Continue'**.

Once you have gained access to the electronic booking system, please click on the event to save a place. The booking system will be live from 3pm on Friday 1 July 2016 until 4pm on the day of the event. If it is necessary to use the extra session on Thursday 14 July, the booking system for this date will be available from Monday 11 July.
