

Passive into Active Learners

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What do we need to see students doing in preparation for and in MFL lessons?

1. Focus in lessons – learning.
2. Good presentation in books – revision.
3. Listen in lessons – peers and teacher.
4. Ask specific questions – ask for specific help.
5. Bring exercise book, vocab book, pen to every lesson.
6. Answer questions – Growth Mindset.
7. Respond to written feedback in exercise book.
8. Complete as much class work as possible to best of ability.
9. Complete ALL homework to best of ability – exam practice/revision.
10. Show resilience – don't give up. 0=0.

What can you expect from the teachers?

1. Focussed teaching – Foundation / Higher.
2. Experience.
3. Marking and feedback.
4. Exam practice.
5. Support – Day 8 or anytime before/after school by appointment / email.
6. Provide materials.
7. Contact re: issues.

What can you do to help at home?

1. 5 minutes vocab learning/day.
2. Check other homework is being done to best of ability.
3. Revision Workbook/Guide.
4. Check books and equipment.
5. Contact Mrs Armstrong – issues.
