

## Year 7 Catch-Up Funding 2014-15

Year 7 catch-up funding provides an additional £500 for every student who did not achieve level 4 or above in reading and/or maths at key stage 2. This funding aims to help these students to 'catch up' with their peers during their first year in secondary school.

In 2014-15, 23 students were eligible for Year 7 catch-up funding, which amounted to £11,500. The analysis of students was as follows:

- 16 students at or below Level 3 in Mathematics and Reading
- 4 students at or below Level 3 in Reading
- 3 students at or below Level 3 in Mathematics

This funding was used on:

- 1-2-1 support in Mathematics and English
- Additional English and Mathematics support in class (including specialist LSAs in Maths)
- Homework club
- Resources to support learning

### Impact on attainment: Year 7 Catch-Up Funding

An analysis of the results for the students eligible in the areas targeted:

Progress Made	English	Maths
Progressed by 2 or more sub levels	15	13
Now working at Level 4 or above	16	16

These results are based on the progression of the students from their Key Stage 2 SAT results to the end of their Year 7 studies.

### Year 7 Catch-Up 2015-16

In 2015-16 Year 7 catch-up funding will be £13,000, with 26 Year 7 students eligible for funding. This funding will once again be used to support the range of interventions used in 2014-15, in particular individual literacy & numeracy support and the provision of small group working in Maths and English.
