In order to assist with the preparation for the GCSE Summer exams, the Year 11 students will sit additional Mock Papers in English, Maths, Science, and RS. The timings of these exams are outlined below.

Monday 18 March

RS – 8:45 ➔ 10:30am

Biology - 1:30 ➔ 3:00pm

Tuesday 19 March

English - 8:45 ➔ 10:30am

Maths 1 (non-calculator) - 1:30 ➔ 3:00pm

Wednesday 20 March

Chemistry - 8:45 ➔ 10:15am

Thurs 21 March

Maths 2 (calculator) - 8:45 ➔ 10:15am

Friday 22 March

Physics - 8:45 ➔ 10:15am

Maths 3 (calculator) - 1:30 ➔ 3:00pm

All students will follow their normal school timetable when they are not in an exam. Students will not be permitted to leave the school site. Students will be given 'break' after their morning exam but should bring in food and drink as the canteen will not be open late. All students should attend pm Registration unless told otherwise. A reminder of the exam regulations can be found below.

Students MUST:

- Line up for morning exams at **8:15am** on the Tennis Courts (unless a different location is specified in the Year 11 Office window).
- Wear correct school uniform.
- Arrive with the correct equipment - students will not be loaned any equipment. Students must write in **BLACK** pen for their examinations.

Examination rules:

- Students are **NOT** permitted to take any coats, bags, scarves or mobile phones into the examination hall – these must be left at home or placed in student's lockers before the examination begins. There will be no other facility in school to store any student's belongings.
- Students who behave in an unacceptable way will be removed from the examination and they will fail.
- If your child is going to be absent through illness, please phone to report his/her absence using the absence line.

If you have any further queries or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Garn in the examination office or me.

As in previous years, we will be running an Easter Revision programme at school from Monday 8 April until Thursday 11 April 2019 inclusive. All sessions will be by invitation only. Every Year 11 student will be invited to an English session and a Maths session; students may also be invited to sessions by other subjects. All students will receive personalised invitations after half term.
