WHY HAVE WE INVITED YOU THIS EVENING?

- ▶ Lack of participation in class discussions
- ▶ '*Don't know*' response when asked questions
- ▶ Minimal effort in written work – answer the question, but not to full ability.
- ▶ (For some of you) Lack of revision

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO MAKE THE MOST OF SOCIOLOGY LESSONS?

- ▶ Summarise the week's work in own notes/revision materials.
- ▶ Volunteer to answer questions or contribute ideas in lessons
- ▶ Ask questions if you do not understand
- ▶ Take ownership of your GCSE – you must have picked it for a reason.
- ▶ Resilient Attitude – it doesn't matter if you don't understand first time, give the summary questions a go.

WHAT CAN BE DONE AT HOME TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD IN MAXIMISING PROGRESS?

- Ask your child what they have done in their lessons each day. For Sociology, ask if they learnt any new theories/concepts.
- Watch the news together. Things we cover in class are always in the news.
- Test them on key concepts/theories
