Dear parent/carers

Arrangement details for this year's examination season.

Welcome back to the summer term 2018. I would like to take this opportunity to inform you about the arrangements for this year's examination season. The timetable for the public examinations is on the school website.

Year 13

The practical examinations will have already started by the time you read this. Other formal examinations begin w/c 14 May, although most of these are initially AS exams. The Year 13 celebration assembly will take place on 25 May. This will mark the end of their studies here at Fullbrook 6 and celebrate their achievements.

Lessons will continue for Year 13 until the 25 May. Study leave will commence from that date. We wish all our students the very best for their final exams.

Year 12

Year 12 will have a busy summer term too. As well as starting the UCAS application process, some will also be sitting AS examinations for a few subjects. All of them will have mock exams w/c 18 June. Because of the conversion from most courses to a two year linear format, there will be no extended year 12 study leave. This is contrary to the calendar dates sent out at the beginning of this year.

For those year 12 and 13 students sitting an AS exam, they will be entitled to half a day preparation time prior to their exam. For example, an afternoon exam will mean they do not have to be in F6 until their exam. A morning exam will entitle them to have the previous afternoon at home studying.

Year 12 students who have taken an AS exam will be expected to continue their lessons in that subject for the remaining few weeks of term. For many, there may still be the option to consider studying that subject into Year 13 once they receive their results in August. Those students who embarked upon an AS study at the start of the year with the expectation to drop the subject at the end of Year 12 should see me for an appointment to clarify arrangements.

Due to the fact that the majority of year 12s will not be sitting AS exams in all their subjects, there will be a summer mock exam session beginning on June 18. A timetable for this will be published shortly. Students will be entitled to have study leave during that week but some lessons will continue for students doing subjects not requiring exams e.g. BTEC and some Arts subjects. Details of all the exam arrangements will be provided to students in an assembly next week and these details will be sent home for your reference. The results from these mock exams will help inform UCAS predicted grades.

Once the Year 12 mock exams have been completed, there will be more focus on post 18 choices. This begins with "Progress Day" on June 26 which will be compulsory for all year 12 students. Following on from this, all Year 12 students will be expected to complete the first draft of their personal statements for UCAS.

Further dates of note is the year 12 work experience during the last week of term and AS/A2 results day on 16 August.
