## Fullbrook Physical Education Kit Policy

At Fullbrook, Physical Education is an important aspect of our students' development and education and they are encouraged to take part in many different physical activities both in lessons and at extra-curricular clubs.

For health & safety reasons, we ask students to remove all jewellery and wear the correct PE kit. All piercings will be asked to be removed as these can cause injuries not only to the student wearing them but also others in the class. Students should refrain from getting any piercings during school term for this reason. With regard to valuables, the school policy is to expect all students to hand in their valuables when changing for PE. The school cannot accept responsibility where this is not done.

#### Girls

Yellow t-shirt (with Fullbrook logo)  
Black shorts  
Black football socks (outdoor)  
White socks (indoor)  
Black hooded jumper (with Fullbrook logo – optional)  
**Plain** (without stripes) black tracksuit trousers (optional)

#### Boys

Grey t-shirt (with Fullbrook logo)  
Black shorts  
White shorts  
Black football socks (outdoor)  
White socks (indoor)  
Rugby top (brown and gold)  
Black hooded jumper (with Fullbrook logo – optional)  
Gum shields (advised for Rugby)

### Year 10-11

#### Girls

Yellow t-shirt (with Fullbrook logo)  
Black shorts  
Black football socks (outdoor)  
White socks (indoor)  
Black hooded jumper (with Fullbrook logo – optional)  
**Plain** (without stripes) black tracksuit trousers (optional)

#### Boys

White t-shirt (with Fullbrook logo)  
White shorts  
Black football socks (outdoor)  
White socks (indoor)  
Rugby top (brown and gold)  
Black shorts  
Gum shields (advised for Rugby)

NB – Students in Years 10 and 11 can purchase and wear the new Fullbrook PE kit.

The Fullbrook Physical Education Kit policy requires all students to change into their PE kit, even if they are excused from the practical element of the lesson. The only exception to this will be if a student is unable to change because of physical incapacity, for example. On occasions when students are unable to do PE, they will be expected to take on a different role within the lesson. This might be as an official, coach or observer. By wearing the Fullbrook PE kit, students who are not participating can ensure they stay warm and prevent their uniforms from getting dirty. If students fail to bring their kit, the usual sanction will apply.
