90% of all the ingredients we use are fresh to ensure students have the opportunity to get a significant proportion of their daily nutritional intake from their School Meal.

Our Cater Link Fresh Food Policy, surpasses the new Government Guidelines set by the School Food Trust. This legislation tells us what we can and can not sell to the pupils in terms of food and drink

The daily menu consists of one main course, a vegetarian option is available daily, vegetables and desert for £2.05

Other items available jacket potatoes with fillings, pasta with sauces and of course salads. Our menus are all nutritionally analysed in line with the School Food Trust Guidelines.

Homemade Rolls, Sandwiches, Panini's and Filled Baguettes are made fresh everyday.

There is also a range of hot and cold desserts and fresh fruit to choose from.

We use plenty of innovative ideas including 'Special Days' and 'Seasonal Menus'.

The Kitchen is led by our Catering Manager Pam Walker, who is always on hand to listen to the students' needs and suggestions.

Cashless System

This cashless system has a number of benefits over a cash dining room; specifically you can rest assured that your money designated for your child gets spent on that purpose.

The following benefits become immediately available with the cashless system.

Reduced queues, faster service at the tills

At the till, place your finger on the scanner and the operator will deduct this from the value of your account. You will be able to see the cost of your meal and the balance left on your account

Free School Meal cards are exactly the same for students who qualify for a free meal. Every day the computer will put £2.05 the price of a two-course meal, on the account If the meal is not used the £2.05 is taken off at the end of the day. The free meal entitlement is only available at lunchtime

You can also put extra money on your account at the revaluation unit if you want to purchase extra items. Of course this extra money will only be taken off the account once you have spent your free allowance.


Look out for our offers
