Dear Parents/Carers of Year 10 and 12 Students,

School Re-opening for Years 10 and 12

You, like us, will have heard for the first time from the Prime Minister over the past 48 hours about the possible next steps that will be taken to move the country forward from 'lockdown'.

In the DfE guidance which followed the Prime Minister's speech it talked of offering "some face-to-face support to supplement the remote education of Year 10 and Year 12 students who are due to take key exams next year". As yet, we have no more information than you do about the way in which this face-to-face support may be offered or the date from which that support should be offered. As soon as we receive further information from the Department for Education, we will be back in touch with you to share our plans in accordance with that guidance.

In the meantime, our status is as it has been since the 23 March – our schools are only open for those children of Critical Workers who need to be cared for while their parents/carers are at work and for those children deemed 'vulnerable'. Online learning continues for all other students.

Please be assured that we are continuing to develop our own plans and as soon as we have received further DfE guidance and the timetable for any face-to-face delivery has been confirmed, we will write to you again to share the relevant information with you.

Your continued support at this time of unprecedented challenge is much appreciated.
