Instructions from Monday 6 July 2020

It has been lovely seeing so many of you for your 'in school' lessons. As we approach the end of Week 2, I can now give you more details about **Weeks 4 & 5**.

Week 4 (July 6 – July 10) – Geog/Hist & MFL

Week 5 (July 13 – July 17) – Year 11 Transition Week

Thus far, you have been coming into school on the same day each week, and you have been with the same students in the same room. During **Week 4**, you will still come into school on the same day of the week that you have been doing so previously. However, your teaching group will change for **Week 4**. In your new teaching group, you will stay with the same students for the morning and afternoon lesson.

During **Week 5**, you will have the opportunity to spend some time in school with your new Year 11 Tutor, and your new Year 11 Tutor Group. More details will come out next week.

We will be following the same process on Show My Homework for you to see which teaching group you are in, and when you need to be in school. There will once again be two spreadsheets for you to look at. The first is a spreadsheet which informs you which teaching group you are in for **Week 4**. The new groups are called 'HumMFL' with a number attached to each. The second spreadsheet tells you when your lessons will take place in school, and which subjects you will have.

A Pop HumMFL Groups 1, 3, 5, 7 – Will come into school on Monday

A Pop HumMFL Groups 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 – Will come into school on Tuesday

B Pop HumMFL Groups 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 – Will come into school on Wednesday

B Pop HumMFL Groups 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 – Will come into school on Thursday

On each day that you are in school, you will have 2 lessons. Each lesson will last for 2 hours. There will be a 10 minute comfort break within each lesson. You will have 30 minutes for Lunch. You must bring a packed Lunch to school. There is no catering on site.

You will see from the second spreadsheet that the lessons start and finish at staggered times. You should arrive 5 minutes before the scheduled start time of Lesson 1, and head straight to your teaching room. Please ensure you are adhering to social distancing rules.

1. If you do not study a Language, you will only come to school for your Geog/Hist lesson.
2. If you do neither a Geog/Hist nor a Language, we will contact you separately.
3. If you study both Geog/Hist and/or two Languages, your lessons have been chosen for you.
Your teacher will email you any of the work from the subject not attended in school.
