### **Autumn Term (Sep-Dec)**

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Half Term

Coursework on project theme (Worth 60% of overall GCSE grade)

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term

Coursework on Project theme with 10 hour Mock end of November.

- Coursework improvements based on mock grade.
- Individual targets set.

Deadline for Improvements of two coursework projects end of January.

### **Spring Term (Jan-Mar)**

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Half Term

1<sup>st</sup> of February EXAM paper distributed. (worth 40% of overall GCSE grade)

- Student Art trip as stimulus.
- Pupils must produce a body of work on a chosen exam title.
- Pupils working to a department given exam brief.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term

Final Exam preparation.

- Students responding to teacher feedback
- Organisation of practical resources.

### **Summer (Apr-July)**

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Half Term

Students sit a 10 hour practical Art exam over two days at the end of April.

- Students organise their portfolio of work that includes a sustained project evidencing the journey from initial engagement to the realisation of intentions and a selection of further work undertaken during the course.
