## WORLD WAR I BATTLEFIELD VISIT

Last week Mrs Teale accompanied four students from Year 10 who had been selected to represent the school on the government-funded [WWI Centenary Battlefield Tours Programme](#). During the trip the students had the opportunity to research details of two local men who fought - and died - during the war. They were able to locate the name of Private Archie Groom from West Byfleet who was killed on 7 October 1916, during the Battle of the Somme. Sadly, Archie's body was never identified and so he is one of more than 70,000 other (mostly) young men with no known grave commemorated on the [Thiepval Memorial](#) to the missing.
