Yesterday, as the nation went to the polls, Fullbrook students had their own opportunity to share their views on who they felt should be the party to lead our country for the next 5 years. The turnout was fantastic, and it was great to see so many wanting to make their vote count.

By the time you receive this newsletter there is likely to be a clear indication of the outcome for our country, but I am delighted to reveal the result of the Fullbrook vote. With 581 votes cast, it was a Labour victory with 27.3% of the ballot, Conservative in close second with 23.7% followed by the Liberal Democrats with 20.4%.

Sadly we weren't able to predict the outcome for the General Election, but it certainly was fascinating insight into the political opinions our students are starting to develop.

CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

It is school policy not to authorize any absence for holiday taken in term time. If parents/carers take their child out of school without authorization they will be liable to receive penalty notices. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 payable within 21 days, rising to £120.00 if paid within 21-28 days. If the penalty notice is not paid within 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child, so a family with 2 parents/carers and 2 children will receive 4 penalty notices. A full explanation is attached to this newsletter and can be found in the attendance policy on our website.
