

Dear Parents/Carers

Easter School Holiday

There have been some queries with regards to the Easter Holidays so I write to address this.

The Easter holiday will take place, as scheduled, from Monday 6 April 2020 to Friday 17 April 2020. During this time teachers will not be setting any new school work for students. Depending on government announcements, learning will re-commence on Monday 20 April 2020.

As the current social isolation restrictions will still be in place during the holiday, it will be a break unlike any we have experienced before. We hope to have some challenges posted on the website for students to engage in if they wish, so that they have some ideas for activities they can do at home during the holiday.

Children of critical workers who have already registered and are working during the Easter break can come to school to take part in a Sports Camp run by Sport4Kids. Letters will be coming to those parents/carers who registered with details and an online form to complete so that Sport4Kids know who to expect.

During the holiday, please continue to follow all government guidance to stay at home so as to prevent the spread of the virus and protect the NHS. Particularly note these key principles (<https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus>):

1. If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they must be.
2. If a child needs specialist support, is vulnerable or has a parent who is a critical worker, then educational provision will be available for them.
3. Parents should not rely for childcare upon those who are advised to be in the stringent social distancing category such as grandparents, friends, or family members with underlying conditions.
4. Parents must also do everything they can to ensure children are not mixing socially in a way which can continue to spread the virus. They must observe the same social distancing principles as adults.
