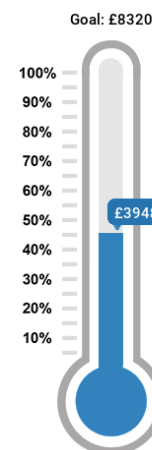
SCIENCE STOOL FUNDRAISING UPDATE
