## LATERAL FLOW TEST REMINDER

We would like to remind parents and carers that students should be testing twice a week at home and the results of each test needs to be reported in two places;

We recommend that students test on Sunday and Wednesday as this creates a pattern that can be easily remembered. It also means that any positive cases identified on a Sunday can be reported to the school ahead of the new week, and makes test and trace much easier.
