Results Days 2021

The arrangements for results days summer 2021 are significantly different this year. Due to the recent increase in local Covid-19 cases, we will not be inviting students into school to collect their results. To ensure the safety of our staff, students and guests, we have taken the decision to issue all results electronically this summer.

On the results days specified below, results will be sent by email directly to the student's school email address:

A-level Results Day: Tuesday 10 August 2021
GCSE Results Day: Thursday 12 August 2021

JCQ (Joint Council for Qualifications) regulations state that centres cannot release results to students until after 8:30am. Fullbrook will issue results after this time as quickly as possible, however, please note that it may take some time for all students to receive their results by email. Any students who have not received their results by 12:00 midday on their results day should notify us by email to grades2021@fullbrook.surrey.sch.uk. All results will also be posted (on results days) to the home address that Fullbrook hold.

Any Year 11 and Year 13 students, who do not currently have access to their school email account, need to email networkhelpdesk@fullbrook.surrey.sch.uk at the earliest opportunity for support in logging in to their school email.

Students will also receive the following information together with their results by email:

- Information about appeals and post-results services
- Details about Autumn 2021 exams for those who would like the opportunity to sit public exams
- Certificate collection arrangements
- UCAS advice (Year 13 students only)

Post-results

Year 11 students will be offered the opportunity to discuss post-16 options. Arrangements for Year 11 students' remote interviews will be sent in a separate email.

Year 13 students, intending to start university in September, will need to login to their UCAS account and follow the guidance there. For any immediate queries regarding Year 13 results and next steps please email cloustont@fullbrook.surrey.sch.uk.

Following the publication of results, senior members of staff will be available by appointment for any student who wishes to discuss their results and do not already have an appointment, which have been
