## **Year 11 Assessment Window 2**

Assessment Window 2 will take place from Monday 28 February - Friday 11 March inclusive. During this time, Year 11 students will sit English, Maths, Science and Religious Studies assessment papers in the assessment hall. All other subjects will conduct in-class assessments during the two-week window.

Students will be provided with a personalised assessment timetable prior to half-term. All subjects will be assessed. When not in an assessment, students will follow their usual timetable.

For core morning assessments, students will be required to register in their tutor rooms from 8:15am. Over the coming weeks, students will be given additional information during registration.

Core subject assessments which are sat by all students at the same time, are scheduled as follows:

Students **MUST**:

- Arrive at their line-up location **30 minutes** before the start of an assessment as stated above.
- Wear correct school uniform.
- Arrive with the correct equipment - students will not be loaned any equipment. Students must write in **BLACK** pen for their examinations.
- Bring lunch and snacks to school as their breaks may be different to the opening times of the school restaurant.

Assessment hall rules:

- Students are **NOT** permitted to take any coats, bags, scarves, watches, or mobile phones into the assessment hall. Only clear bottles (with no markings whatsoever - including measurements) which contain water will be allowed into the assessment hall.
- Students who behave in an unacceptable way will be removed from the assessment and they will score zero.

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- If your child is going to be absent through illness, please phone to report his/her absence using the absence line.

For in-class assessments, all mobile phones, smart watches, and other personal electronic devices should be switched off and placed inside bags.

As explained to students before the December Assessments, should public exams be cancelled in the Summer, these assessments will form a part of the evidence used for TAGs (Teacher Assessed Grades). With this in mind, students should make every effort to sit them, which will allow them to demonstrate the progress they have made.

### **Easter Revision**

In our continuing effort to support students with their preparation for GCSEs, we will be running an Easter Revision programme at school from Monday 4 April until Friday 8 April inclusive. All sessions are by invitation only and these will be sent out after half term.
