SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL SCHOOL TRAVEL SURVEY

Our school are assisting Surrey County Council's Safer Travel Team to undertake research with parents on pupils' types of travel to and from school. This follows the huge success that the previous survey had, with over 7,000 parents and guardians completing the survey.

The objective of the research is to develop a better understanding of the different types of travel, how frequently they're used, why that type is used.

Once the Safer Travel Team have collected and analysed this information provided by parents, their goal is to obtain a better understanding of journeys to school, so they can continue encouraging safer and more active travel to school for all children in Surrey.


