UKMT JUNIOR MATHS CHALLENGE

A group of our Year 7s and 8s took part in the UKMT Junior Maths Challenge a few weeks ago and we have had some great results! We smashed our record for the number of certificates since Fullbrook start participating. Just under 70% of all students received a Bronze (top 25% of all of UK), Silver (top 17%) or Gold (top 8%). This week we would like to highlight another great read from this month's reading list on **Thought provoking books**.

Ground Zero by Alan Gratz tells the story of two characters, Brandon who was visiting his Dad's workplace in the World Trade Centre on September 11th 2001 and Reshmina who lives in Afghanistan.

Gratz alternates between the two narratives in short, nail-biting chapters that create vivid images of each setting and makes the reader feel connected in both character's relationships and choices. The uplifting message of the importance of humanity working with, not against, one another comes through brilliantly.
