#### <u>INSPIRED TO</u> <u>ACHIEVE FAIR -</u> REMINDER


Don't forget the Fullbrook 6 Inspired to Achieve fair takes place on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June between 5-7pm.

When the mural is being created/complete, we will share more details with you, but in the meantime, please see page 4 for some pictures of the artist's visit with the students.


#### YEAR 9 ARTWORK


