

## Covid Update June 2022

The current advice from Surrey CC is that Covid should be treated in a similar way to general respiratory infections.

Key things to be aware of include:

Students with **mild symptoms** such as a runny nose, sore throat, or mild cough, who are otherwise well, **can continue to attend their education setting**.

Students who are unwell and have a **high temperature should stay at home** and avoid contact with other people until they no longer have a high temperature

If a student has a **positive covid test result** they should **stay at home for 3 days after the day they took the test** and avoid contact with other people

Students who **live with someone who has tested positive** should **continue to attend school** as normal.
