# **REFURBISHMENT OF C BLOCK TOILETS**

As explained in a letter to parents/carers last week, the C block girls' toilets are being refurbished and converted to unisex toilets for September. All unisex toilets have individual floor to ceiling cubicals, with shared hand washing facilitites. This means that, by September, Fullbrook will have two sets of girls' toilets, two sets of boys' toilets and two sets of unisex toilets as well as the boys and girls' toilets in the sports hall for use during PE lessons and the existing disabled toilet facilitates. From September, students will be able to choose use any of the toilet facilities appropriate to them.

Unisex toilets are being employed everywhere from event venues and restaurants to work places and schools. In schools, unisex washrooms have been shown to cut down bullying dramatically as it removes the closed-off confined spaces where this can commonly occur. The space can be more open by design, which also prevents vandalism and other misbehaviour as the area is used by a wider number of students, and can be monitored more effectively. Unisex toilets are also more inclusive.

At Fullbrook we aim to support all our students which is why we will have a range of toilet facilitites on our site. Images of the current unisex toilet facilities can be seen below. :
